

Our Covid Policy from May 2021

We're really looking forward to re-opening on 18th May and will be following closely the Government guidelines.

It is now a legal requirement to wear a face covering when entering the restaurant and whilst not seated, unless you are exempt. For example, you will need to wear a face covering whilst being seated, when visiting the bathroom and when leaving the restaurant.

Until 21st June, you may only book a restaurant table at the Union Inn to dine as a maximum group of 6 or as a larger party of 2 households and support bubble.

In order to keep all our customers and staff safe as the latest lockdown eases, we politely request the minimum participation from our customers before entry onto our premises.

- Not enter our premises if you or members of your party have symptoms of coronavirus, if any of you live in a household or are in a support bubble with anyone showing symptoms, or if any of you are subject to quarantine procedures or have been requested to self-isolate as part of the government Track and Trace service.
- Use hand sanitiser upon entry.
- All party members aged 16 or over will be required to check in individually using the NHS Track & Trace system on their mobile phones or otherwise will need to leave their handwritten contact details at the door. Unfortunately, anyone not leaving their details will not be able to enter.
- All diners to arrive promptly at their allotted arrival time. If you arrive early or late, you may be requested to wait outside whilst we facilitate diners arriving on time.

Despite the above restrictions, we are very much looking forward to welcoming you back to the Union Inn Denbury.
